Then a similar championship on a national scale which was just held by Pengprov TI Banten some time ago. Alhamdulillah, these championships were successfully implemented and received a positive response from the Indonesian taekwondo community. Hopefully the E â€" Poomsae National Championship will also run successfully and smoothly.†Bright Thamrin Marzuki.

In this championship, several categories were competed, including: Individual Men, Individual Women, Pairs, Men's Team, Women's Team and *Freestyle*. In addition, participants from various regions throughout Indonesia such as Banten Province, North Sulawesi, Central Sulawesi, West Sumatra, Central Kalimantan, East Kalimantan, West Java, Central Java, East Java, DKI Jakarta, North Sumatra, Aceh, West Nusa Tenggara, Riau, Lampung, Southeast Sulawesi, Bali, South Kalimantan, South Sumatra, South Sulawesi, Kep. Riau.

For the championship this time it could not be done face to face as usual, but was done *online* and the venue was held in their respective places.



The UPNVJ Public Relations Team had the opportunity to conduct an *online* interview with Riviangela, who is usually called Angel, "The preparations have been prepared a week before the championship, because I just happened to be given the information to take part in the championship a week before the championship so the preparation was not very good but thank God I can still be professional." and perform to the fullest.†he said

Angel also talked about her ups and downs during the preparation for this activity, "lf you are asked about your ups and downs, there must be a lot, Sis. Angel hopes that there will still be many other achievements that he can get, "My hope is that in the future it will be even better, and with this championship it can make me even more enthusiastic and I can take part in championships not only at the national level but can participate in International level such as Asian Games, Sea Games etc. And also can follow the PON. My message is that I hope that Covid-19 will pass quickly so that you can take part in lectures and
