


Socialization Activities for Research Guidelines, Community Service Guidelines, Exposure to Intellectual Property Rights & Publication of LPPM

This socialization activity was held online using the zoom meeting facility. With the socialization mechanism divided into 2 days, the first day the socialization was carried out for FEB, FISIP and FH presented by 138 UPNVJ permanent lecturers. Lewoleba, SH., MH. Finally, the publication by Lukman Saleh W, S.IP., M.IKom. The activity continued with a question and answer agenda.
