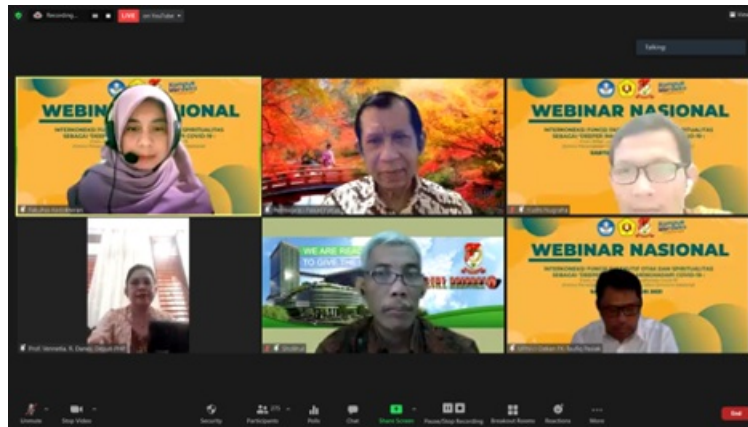




Health Problems During the Covid-19 Pandemic Becomes the Big Theme of the UPNVJ FK National Webinar

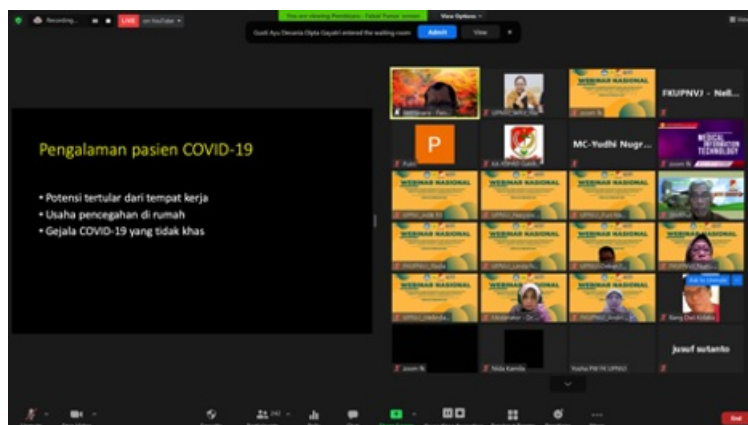
