Until finally it was announced for the top 5 winners, where myself Angginun Juwita Sari Harahap won 1st place, followed by 2nd place from the University of Indonesia, 3rd place from Gajah Mada University, 4th place from the University of Indonesia, and 5th place from Gajah Mada University," said Angginun to the PR team.

Angginun considers that this competition invites innovations owned by youth to be realized in real action, and are able to compete with clear and focused ideas.

Angginun also briefly described the preparations she made to take part in this competition, "The most important thing in my preparation for this competition is confidence and argumentation, because all things judged must be based on clear data and facts. Besides that, I practiced public speaking so I wasn't nervous when answering the jury's questions.
