As a follow-up to the cooperation plan, Dr. Arif Abdullah Sagran, as Deputy Chancellor for Cooperation at Universidade Dili will pay a visit to UPNVJ on Thursday (19/01) in order to hold a *courtesy call* with the Chancellor and his staff, as well as carry out the signing of *a Memorandum of Understanding* (MoU) and discuss the implementation of the cooperation program that located in Nusantara Meeting Room 1. This activity was carried out to strengthen the relationship between the two Universities and to open opportunities for cooperative relations between UPNVJ and various universities in the Timor Leste region.
