

Collaboration between Susvill FISIP 2024 X Camy.id: A Touching Moment for Cijantur Children Learning National Defense with FISIP UPNVJ

HumasUPNVJ - The Sustainable Village Program is held again with the theme "KOMPAK: Maximum Collaboration for Sustainable Development and Action." . The Student Executive Board of BEM Universitas Pembangunan Nasional Veteran Jakarta (BEM UPNVJ) together with 7 other faculties collaborated together with a focus on development in their respective fields. One of them is by collaborating with the Faculty of Social and Political Sciences (FISIP) with a focus on developing education for elementary school children who discuss understanding the values of norms, national insight or national defense, Clean and Healthy Living Behavior (PHBS), introduction to the potential of natural resources in Kampung Cijantur, and prevention of sexual violence. In addition, as an effort to increase children's creativity and community environmental awareness, FISIP also involves children in ecobricks learning by introducing organic and inorganic waste, management, and recycling of waste, one of which is in the form of ecobricks sofa work.

Head of FISIP Development Division, Adam Mukhtar explained that the learning process is packaged interactively so that children can more easily absorb and understand the material presented. On the first day, the agenda was opened with a joint painting activity on the terrace

class. The participants of the activity were quite numerous and enthusiastic with the support of the main sponsor, **Camy.id** in providing painting needs, one of which was tote bags and other painting equipment. The purpose of this painting activity was to encourage them to express their ideas and build creativity with the expressions they have. This is expected to build their self-confidence in creating works or expressing expressions. The second day of the program was marked by an increase in the number of participants, reflecting the high enthusiasm of the people of Kampung Cijantur. On this day, the activity began with PHBS education. Children were taught to wash their hands with the correct technique while being accompanied by songs to create a pleasant atmosphere. The activity continued with material about bullying and steps to prevent violence, and ended with an interactive quiz and giving prizes to children who actively participated.

"We want to instill national values, love for the homeland, and honesty as a solid foundation so that children can contribute to society in the future," explained Adam Mukhtar in an interview. **Camy.id** also contributes and is committed to presenting innovative and interactive learning methods for children in the village.

Through *Sustainable Village 2024*, it is hoped that good and sustainable education will be created for the young generation of Kampung Cijantur. This program aims to form future leaders who not only have intellectual competence, but also strong character, integrity, and high commitment to society, nation, and state.
